branch was added to the portfolio – and then the Kendal shop came along in 1990 to complete the picture.

In the last 25 years technology has moved at a tremendous pace, probably more than it developed in the previous 250 years together.

When Barry and Phil took over the business back in 1984 there were only three TV channels to choose from and only the well-to-do had a remote

control, while video recorders cost £500-£600 – practically the cost of a small car.

Barry said: "Satellite was introduced in the late 1980s and round the house TVs became the norm.

"Most families had moved from one 'box' to one in each room. The 90s brought digital in terms of satellite, recording, radio and a bonanza of multiple channels – and the next decade promises even more with internet TV, wireless feeds around the house and the much talked about 3D TV."

Robinsons Electric have been there throughout and, come recession or shine, plan to be available for the next 25 years and beyond as technology takes us foward.
